The American Society of Civil Engineers, Buffalo Section (ASCE) is in its eighteenth year of sponsoring the "Engineering Expressions" program developed by Irvine G. Reinig II, P.E. in 1989-90 for ASCE. The purpose of the program is to introduce children, 10 to 12 years of age, to engineering principles and to engineering, as a profession. The program includes several interactive workshops and demonstrations including: concrete mixing, earthquake simulation, foundations, soil mechanics, miniature bridge building, and CAD drawing. During the past 18 years, the program has been presented to several Buffalo public schools and organizations like the girl scouts and boy scouts; thus educating over 6,600 children in the Western New York Area. Recently on January 24th, "Engineering Expressions" took place at City Honors High School on Best Street in Buffalo.

Colleen O'Connell, Nussbaumer's Junior Civil Engineer, was a participant in the program and administered an introductory workshop on CAD drawing to their sixth grade class. Hopefully, she has inspired the young minds of future engineers!
